

## Microsoft Campus Agreement

### Faculty/Staff information page

Your college or university participates in a **Microsoft® Campus Agreement** (<http://www.collegebuys.org> > Answer Center > Answer ID number "14") that is sponsored or supported by the Foundation for California Community Colleges (FCCC).

Participating colleges have paid an annual subscription license fee allowing faculty/staff to order media (CD-ROMs) for work-at-home use. Faculty/staff are only paying to lease the media. The media is fully licensed as long as your college's/university's Microsoft® Campus Agreement is in place and you remain an eligible employee. The license provides that you may only order one of each program during the license year; you are, however, allowed to order one copy of a NEW revision or version upon its release. Windows® upgrades require that a Windows® operating system (OS) be previously installed on your computer. All disks are fully guaranteed; defective disks are replaced at no charge within 30 days of delivery.
