Employment Opportunity With Immediate Openings Police Academy Scenario Role Player *Learn About Law Enforcement*

Position: Scenario role players are part time employees of Napa Valley College assigned to the Criminal Justice Training Center to role play for scenario tests administered as part of the basic police academy. Role players follow a script and act out various parts involved in law enforcement calls for service including crime victims, witnesses, and suspects. Scenario scenes include assaults, crimes in progress, drunk driving accidents, and other investigative police contacts.

This is an excellent way to learn more about law enforcement and the police academy. It is an ideal opportunity for police cadets, community service officers, reserve officers, law enforcement students, and anyone interested in learning more about law enforcement training and law enforcement practices.

Role players are paid \$6.75 per hour.

Minimum Qualifications:

- ❑ Be at least 18 years of age.
- ❑ Have a valid California Drivers' License and no felony convictions.

Desirable Qualifications:

- ❑ Be available evening and weekend hours.
- ❑ Have an interest in law enforcement.

Selection Process: Applicants should contact the Criminal Justice Training Center in building 1000 at Napa Valley College (707-253-3255). Persons selected to work as role players will receive training prior to being assigned to a scenario testing process. Anyone interested in this opportunity is encouraged to apply at anytime during the year. Scenario testing is typically scheduled on Saturday evenings.
