CAMPUS LAW ENFORCEMENT

- PURPOSE:** This course is designed for community college and K-12 peace officers who must receive 40 hours of specific educational law enforcement training in order to meet the requirements of SB1627. The course covers roles and responsibilities of campus law enforcement officers, laws specific to the educational environment, tactical awareness, mediation and conflict resolution, emergency procedures and the dynamics of student behavior.
