LGBT Awareness For California Law Enforcement Training For Trainers – Online Course

PURPOSE: This course prepares instructors to facilitate LGBT awareness training as specified in California Penal Code section 13519.41 (effective January 1, 2019) for academy students, peace officers, dispatchers and other law enforcement professionals. The learning outcomes for this course include:

- The student will demonstrate an understanding of the LGBT awareness course content required by California Penal Code section 13519.41.
- The student will understand how to use learning activities to deliver course content related to LGBT awareness training for law enforcement.
- The student will identify the documents required to get a course of training certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.

Participants will receive a complete training package for the LGBT Awareness for Law Enforcement course including a textbook and two Instructor Guides with outlines, lesson plans, and learning activities. Participants will complete the LGBT Awareness for Law Enforcement Basic Course and meet the requirements of 13519.41 PC.
