LGBT Awareness for California Law Enforcement Training for Trainers - Online

DESCRIPTION: This course prepares instructors to facilitate LGBT awareness training as specified in California Penal Code section 13519.41 (effective January 1, 2019) for peace officers, dispatchers and other law enforcement professionals. The learning outcomes for this course include:

1. The student will identify the required course content for LGBT awareness training pursuant to California Penal Code section 13519.41.
2. The student will understand how to use learning activities to deliver course content related to LGBT awareness training for law enforcement.
3. The student will identify the documents required to get a course of training certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.

Participants will have access to a complete training package for the LGBT Awareness For Law Enforcement course including a student workbook and the instructor guide with course outlines, lesson plans, and learning activities (all in PDF format) and hard copy textbook.

DATES: Available to start anytime between January 3 and June 24, 2022. Online courses must be completed by 5:00PM the last day of class. No extensions are possible.

COST: \$70.00 includes course fees and registration.

LOCATION: Online using the Canvas Learning Management System (Internet connection required. (No special software required)

CERTIFICATIONS: P.O.S.T Certified - Plan IV, Provides 8 hours of CPT credit.
