## PC 832 Arrest

**DESCRIPTION:** This course fulfills the requirements of Penal Code Section 832 for peace officers. Satisfactory completion of this course must be demonstrated by passing POST-developed examinations that include a written test and an arrest control performance test. **This course does not include firearms training.**

**PAYMENT INFORMATION:** Only full payment reserves a seat. Reservations are made on a "first-paid, first- reserved" basis.

### **COLLEGE APPLICATION PROCESS:**

**Agency Personnel:** Required to complete the college application process and submit a CJTC Credit Registration Form at least 15 business days prior to the class start date.

**Self-sponsored students:** Required to complete the college application process and submit a CJTC Credit Registration Form at time of reservation.

**CANCELLATION/ REFUND POLICY:** Cancellations received 15 business days prior to the first day of class are eligible for a full refund. All material fees are non-refundable within 15 business days of the first day of class. This class requires a minimum enrollment of students. Should the class be cancelled, students will be notified 15 business days prior to the first day of class.

**PARKING:** A parking permit is not required for exempt vehicles. A daily \$2.00 parking permit is required for all other vehicles. Permits can be purchased from parking machines located in the parking lots. Students may not park in any area painted orange or marked as STAFF parking. This includes marked and un-marked police vehicles.

**LAPTOP:** Students must bring a laptop computer with wireless internet capabilities. Course materials will be provided to students on a USB drive.

**DRESS CODE:** Dress code for this course is business casual. No shorts, sandals/ flip flops, sweat pants, or logoed t-shirts. Appropriate athletic clothing and indoor-only mat shoes is required for the weaponless defense portion of the class.
